Welcome! Below is an outline of the steps needed to apply to Camp Promise.

In addition to your online application, you will need to download, print, and sign forms, and then upload them back to your application. You will be able to access all of these forms once you register as a user in our system and begin your online application.

Due to high interest, space at camp is limited. Applications are processed on a rolling basis. Applicants must submit an online application AND complete an interview with our leadership team to be considered for a spot in a cabin. We expect camp sessions to fill up quickly, so please complete your online application and interview as soon as possible.

CAMPER Application Checklist

1. Online Application – Rolling Admission Until Cabin Capacity Is Reached

- Upload the following documents to your application:
 - Current photo
 - Government-issued ID (campers 18+ only)
 - Insurance card (front and back)
 - Signed Waivers
 - Signed Participation Agreement

Applicants will not be considered for a spot at camp until after completing their interview. For returning campers, interviews are done via phone, and for new campers, we like to use Google Hangout video chat so applicants can meet our team face-to-face.

 - Signed and completed Medical Form
 - Copy of immunization records
 - Additional medical directives (optional)

- Accepted campers will receive a Welcome Packet via email that includes a camper handbook, list of theme days, packing list, and directions to camp.
