CAMP PROMISE

Camp Promise offers fun, innovative activities that teaches campers life skills and introduces campers to new experiences through adaptation, technology, creativity, and special guests. We pair campers one-to-one with a counselor who serves as the camper's buddy for the week and helps them enjoy camp fully, while ensuring their needs are being met. Camp Promise programs include **overnight sessions**, **virtual summer sessions**, **year-round programming**, and **18+ retreat camp sessions**.

EDUCATION

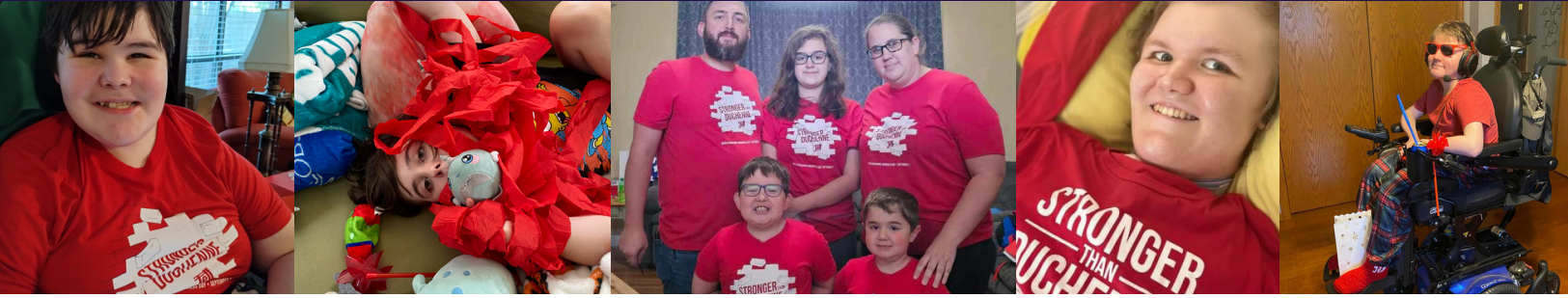
Through our educational programming initiatives, we empower those in the Duchenne community with the knowledge needed to be their own best advocates, spread awareness about Duchenne in the medical field, and help accelerate research and development. We cover a broad range of topics from an introduction to Jett Foundation direct-service programs to standards of care and available clinical trials or treatment options. We offer day-long **family workshops**, live hour-long **community webinars**, and **educational packages** all free of cost for individuals, families, clinicians, and others impacted by Duchenne across the country that provide crucial information, support, and resources.

FAMILY SUPPORT

Our **Community Ambassador** program empowers individuals, parents, grandparents, and others impacted by Duchenne across the country to be spokespeople on behalf of Jett Foundation. Ambassadors assist our team in educating others impacted by Duchenne through **parent support groups**, providing feedback to our pharmaceutical partners, and raising necessary funds for Jett Foundation programs.

JETT GIVING FUND

Jett Giving Fund provides financial assistance to individuals and families impacted by Duchenne who are in need of a helping hand. Jett Giving Fund offers families financial assistance through three main branches of support: the **Accessible Vehicle Fund**, the **Emergency Fund**, and the **Equipment Assistance Fund**. The Accessible Vehicle Fund helps families obtain safe, accessible transportation. The Emergency Fund provides grants to families facing unexpected, emergency situations for things like rent/mortgage payments, utility payments, groceries, and more. The Equipment Assistance Fund helps families with small accessibility or medical items that are either not covered by insurance or too expensive.
